Biography

Juergen M. Bauer is working as assistant medical director at the Department of Geriatric Medicine at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg. His research work and academic career are currently supported by a four year scholarship of the Robert-Bosch-Foundation. In recent years, Juergen M. Bauer's research interest has been focused on nutrition and its relationship with functionality in older persons. In this field he has published numerous original papers and reviews.

Before moving into the field of geriatric medicine Juergen M. Bauer was trained in gastroenterology and as a specialist in clinical nutrition. During this time he was responsible for the development of an outpatient centre for the treatment of obesity.

Juergen M. Bauer is a member of several national and international medical societies including the European Society for Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism (ESPEN). Since 2005 he is chairman of the ESPEN Special Interest Group "Nutrition in Geriatrics". He is also a member of the executive board of the Union of European Medicine Societies (EUMS) and serves as general secretary.

He is on the editorial board of the *Journal of Nutrition, Health and Aging* and of the *Journal of European Geriatric Medicine*. He has been a peer-reviewer for a variety of scientific journals in the field of geriatric medicine and nutrition.

Juergen M. Bauer is currently a member of several international expert groups that work on guidelines and definitions in the field of nutrition and functionality in older persons.

He holds part-time lectureships in geriatric medicine and psychogerontology at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg.

In 2007 Juergen M. Bauer has been awarded the honorary prize of the German Geriatric Society.
