Biography

Tommy Cederholm started his career in Internal medicine, and in the early 1980ies he was already interested of the catabolic mechanisms behind depletion in chronic disorders.

The dissertation 1994 at Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm outlined the importance of inflammatory activities in non-malignant cachexia. Ever since his research interest has focused on energy, fat and protein interactions with catabolism, inflammation and nutritional status in elderly, chronically ill and demented subjects. Since 1995 he works as a senior consultant in Geriatrics.

Uppsala University appointed him Professor of Clinical Nutrition in 2005.

His publications include some 90 peer-reviewed articles, numerous international abstract presentations and PhD student supervisions.

The Swedish National Food Administration makes use of him in their Expert Council for Food and Health. He was in the organizing committee of the ESPEN Congress in Stockholm 1999, and he is the chairman of SWESPEN, and active in the ESPEN SIG Geriatric Nutrition.
