<b>History:</b>	1912 - First Nestlé trading office established in Ho Chi Minh City (formerly Saigon)  1992 - La Vie Company, a joint venture between Nestlé and Perrier Vittel, established in Long An  1995 - Nestlé Vietnam established. First factory built, in Dong Nai province
<b>Headquartered in:</b>	Ho Chi Minh City
<b>Geographic presence:</b>	5 factories 2 distribution centres
<b>Number of employees:</b>	More than 2,000
<b>Brands include:</b>	<i>Nescafé, Milo, Maggi, Nesvita and La Vie</i>
<b>Investment in new Nescafé factory:</b>	CHF 230 million
